Who are the Sutton Trust?

What are Pathways Programmes?

Pathways programmes are two-year programmes that are designed to give you an insight into exciting professions as well as university life. Along the way, you will start thinking about your next steps after leaving school – learning more about university, apprenticeships and what career path will suit you. All this while meeting employers and making new friends! These programmes are completely free to attend and be a part of – there will never be a cost for you!

Which programmes can you get involved in?

There are 5 exciting professions to choose from that you can see on the screen. If you have considered any of those careers in your future or you are simply curious in learning about more, then make sure to apply! Remember – there is no pressure that you go into those careers after, it is equally as important to learn about what you don't like as well as what you do like.

What will you do on a Pathways Programme?

Each Pathways programme is different and designed around the different professions but up on the screen are just some of the things you could be getting up to over the next two years.

There is opportunity to gain real-life hands-on experience with The Sutton Trusts partner firms across the range of professions and undertake some of the work that professionals get up to every day. This will allow you to get stuck in and see whether that career is really for you, which parts you like and don't like – all the while massively enhancing your CV while you are still at school! You will also develop invaluable skills as you communicate with employers, organisation skills as you start to plan your time as well as carving out more specific skills related to your chosen profession.

You will have the opportunity to attend networking events and meet a wide range of different employers and professionals across your chosen industry. At these events, you will be able to ask questions on their career, find out all of their tips and experience on how they have succeeded and how you can translate those experiences to your future steps.

Depending on which programme you are on you may also be able to attend university events allowing you a unique insight into university life and the different styles of teaching to see whether university could be for you. You will also gain application support and guidance to help when thinking about those steps.

The programme goes beyond the two years and once you have completed and graduated the programme, you will have access to our alumni network full of tips and resources to help you navigate life after university and those early days in your career!

Summer School

The Summer school and national conference is a fantastic opportunity to gain an insight into university life and immerse yourself into your profession.

There are a whole host of benefits that you can see on the screen – from exploring the academic side of university and attending lectures, through to what attending university would be like – making new friends and trying new social activities.

Placements

Over your Pathways programme there will be the opportunity to undertake a work placement or attend an insight week with a leading organisation.

The placement will last 3-5 days and you will be immersed into the sector, gain key skills and meet professionals. You will develop skills that will benefit you as you leave school and start to think about your future.

How to get involved

There are two streams of programmes that you can be a part of.

Pathways face to face programmes takes place at our university hubs across the country that you can see on the screen. If you live in a reasonable commuting distance from those universities (usually within an hour travel each way) then you are eligible to join a face-to-face programme where there will likely be a mix of in person events and online events throughout the two years.

If you do not live in a commuting distance from the university, or you prefer working digitally, then you can join us for our Pathways Online programme. These will take place fully virtually and you will be able to participate in all the sessions and activities from the comfort of your very own home.
